Present petition is for release of petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.12 dated 08.01.2015, under Section 376 IPC and later added Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case by levelling the allegations that he had developed relations with the complainant Babita and assured her that he will marry her.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from investigating officer, has informed that the charges have been framed on 13.11.2016 and till date the statement of the complainant has not been recorded.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and with their able assistance gone through the material available on record.

The petitioner was arrested on 20.08.2016. Since then, he is in judicial custody and no useful purpose would be served to further detain him in jail. The final conclusion of trial will take a long time.

In view of above facts, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.

Needless to mention that, nothing observed here-in-above, would reflect, on merits in the trial of the main case, in any manner.
