This order shall dispose of aforementioned four petitions filed by the petitioners under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.119 dated 25.08.2017 under Sections 307, 326-B, 427, 436, 201, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 Explosive Substances Act, 1908 registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioners state that similarly placed accused have been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 18.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-44653-2017 *Kuldeep Singh v. State of Punjab etc.* The petitioners have also been named in the same FIR.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of order of this Court passed in the case of ***Kuldeep Singh (supra)***, the present petitions are allowed, in same terms, subject to furnishing of their bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

However, the petitioners shall deposit Rs.20,000/- each with the trial Court while furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds and disbursement of the same shall be subject to outcome of the trial.
