As per FIR, the role attributed to the present petitioner (Teetu @ Jaswinder Kumar) is that he was having a datar, whereas his co-accused Suraj was having a sword. They were alleged to have inflicted injuries upon Harjanmeet Singh, Gulwinder Singh, Harmandeep Singh and Inderjeet Kaur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that aforesaid Suraj has been granted bail and no recovery of sword has been effected from him. He further stated that the injuries are simple in nature. Vide orders dated 03.09.2014 (Annexures P-2, P-3 and P-4), Suraj Kumar, Vicky and Jatinder alias Ghudhu have already been ordered to be released on bail. Learned State counsel has further informed that challan has not been presented till date.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court that petitioner has joined the investigation on 17.01.2017 and other accused has already been granted regular bail. He further submits that no further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required in the matter.

In view of the above, interim order dated 09.01.2017 is made absolute and the present petition is disposed of as such.
