Pursuant to the interim order dated 19.12.2016 passed in this petition, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baldev Raj, submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and has been admitted to bail, though proceedings under Section 174-A of the IPC are ongoing against him.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has surrendered, subject to his continuing to appear before the trial Court as and when summoned, both in the complaint instituted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, as also in the case registered against him under Section 174-A IPC, the order dated 19.12.2016 is made absolute, without making any comment upon the merits of either case.
