Pursuant to the order dated 11.01.2017, summoning the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, she (Mrs. Alka Meena) is present in Court and has expressed her regret with regard to the person who came to assist the learned State counsel on the previous date, not being aware of the complete details of the case.

Other than that, she has been asked as to why no investigation had actually been carried out till this Court intervened in this petition seeking anticipatory bail. Again she has expressed her regret on the aforesaid.

Be that as it may, as regards this petition seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.
