Petitioner-Tejpal Singh alias Bittu has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.129 dated 19.08.2016, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 307, 323, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and the complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that although the petitioner has been named in the FIR and stated to be armed with *datar*, but no injury has been attributed to him.

Moreover, the challan has already been presented and the petitioner has been in custody since 01.10.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
