The petitioner is seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail allowed to respondent no.2 by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed in CRM-M-15066-2015 as respondent no.2 has not complied with the conditions of said order of deposit of Rs.1,10,000/-, which he had withdrawn from the account of his wife and Rs.2,50,000/-. The amount was to be deposited within two months of the order.

Complainant had filed this petition. Notice of motion was issued. Respondent no.2 - Ramandeep Singh appeared and sought time to deposit the amount. The order was passed in July 2017. The matter was

adjourned to 18.07.2017. The respondent failed to appear and therefore, CJM, Amritsar was asked to issue bailable warrants of arrest to procure his presence.

Respondent no.2 – Ramandeep Singh is present in the Court. He says that he has no money, therefore, he cannot comply with the conditions. He further states that he is ready to surrender before the Court below.

There is an objection on behalf of the complainant and it is urged that it is over a year that the order had been passed and has not been complied with.

The order (Annexure P-3) allowing anticipatory bail is recalled.

ASI Devinder Singh, P.S. Jandiala is present in the Court. He is directed to take respondent no.2 - Ramandeep Singh into custody and produce him before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petition is allowed.
