Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.373 dated 03.10.2017 under Sections 379-A, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Madhuban, Distirct Karnal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case and the allegation against the petitioner is that he had snatched of Rs.1900/- from the upper pocket of the complainant and also pushed him. More so, he is in custody since 16.10.2017 and decision of the case still to take some more time. So he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature, therefore he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel

decision of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, Karnal.

The petition stands allowed.
