1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

On the request of Manjit Kaur mother of petitioner no.1, she was allowed to talk with petitioner no.1. Petitioner no.1 does not want to accompany her mother.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 20.11.2017. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure P-3. The true typed copies of Aadhar Card of petitioner No.1 petitioner No.2, showing their date of birth have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 20.11.2017 (Annexure-P-4) before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to consider the

application of the petitioners dated 20.11.2017 (Annexure-P-4) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage. Disposed of accordingly.
