Following is the prayer in both the petitions:-

Petitioner has filed CRM-M-45398-2016 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for protection of life and liberty to the petitioners and issuance of directions to the respondent to give 7 days notice in case petitioner is required to be arrested in FIR No. 128 dated 29.7.2016, registered under Sections 409, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 8, 9 and 13 of PC Act, 1988, at Police Station West, Sector-11, Union Territory of Chandigarh.

Petitioner has filed CRM-M-8000-2017 under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 128 dated 29.07.2016, registered under Sections, 409, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 8, 9 and 13 of PC Act, 1988, at Police Station West, Sector-11, Union Territory of Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for U.T., on instructions from a police official, makes a statement that there should not be any difficulty in giving 7 days' notice as prayed for.

In that view of the matter this petition is disposed of with a direction to give 7 days notice to the petitioner, as prayed for.
