Petitioner-Rakesh Kumar Bharara has filed this petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of a direction to respondent No.4 to arrest the accused persons named in FIR No.298 dated 29.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of Indian Penal at Police Station Ambala City and to file the challan/final report after completing the investigating.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the extent that the official respondents may be directed to complete the investigation expeditiously and to present the final report before the Court.

Mr. Parveen Aggarwal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents-State and submits that he has no objection in allowing the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that FIR in the present case was

registered on 29.09.2015, but the investigation of the same has not been completed so far, therefore, the respondents are directed to complete the investigation expeditiously and present the final report, whatever, before the Court.
