The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No.30, dated 20.04.2016, under Sections 15/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is 150 kilograms of poppy husk and from a car in which the petitioner was travelling.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner would vehemently contend that it is a case of false implication. It is further submitted that the petitioner has already faced incarceration of 9 months and the trial is at the very initial stage in as much as no prosecution witness has been examined till date.

Be that as it may, in the light of heavy and commercial quantity of contraband effected from the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner, concession of bail.

Petition is dismissed.
