INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Gurmeet Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.111 dated 04.08.2017, registered at Police Station Guru Har Sahai, District Ferozepur, under Sections 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that first petition was decided by this Court on merit vide order dated 10.11.2017 wherein it was held that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation. The allegation against the present petitioner is that he talked with Harmesh Singh, son of complainant that he should come to Kuwait and he will take visa for him within 15-20 days. As per the FIR, ₹1,60,000/- was paid to Sukhjot Singh and after taking

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the said amount, Sukhjit Singh went to Kuwait, but no visa was arranged.

Now again, the petition for anticipatory bail has been filed without any change in circumstances after passing of the order dated 10.11.2017.

No ground is made out to grant the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
