ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.19 dated 18.01.2017 under Sections 380/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that he had stolen money from Golak of Gurudwara. He further contends that the incident is stated to have taken place on 31.12.2014, but the complaint was given after more than a year, on 20.02.2016. It is also contended that in pursuance to the order dated 13.02.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Baljit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation. It is further contended that Challan has been prepared and shall be filed in the Court shortly.

In view of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that petitioner has joined investigation, but without commenting on the merits of case, the order dated 13.02.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
