RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(Oral)

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.102 dated 21.11.2016, registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 326, 451, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

As per allegations in the FIR, injuries on right hand thumb and left ear of the complainant (Jagdeep Singh) have been attributed to the petitioner. Perusal of the FIR would show that Sukhjeet Singh also inflicted iron rod blow on the left thumb of the complainant. Harpreet Singh son of Harbhajan Singh also

inflicted *kirpan* blow on the left ear of the complainant. In all four injuries were found on the person of the complainant. Injury No.2 on the left hand lateral aspect was found to be bone deep and was in dimension of 6cm x 1cm and was grievous in nature. Apparently as per prosecution case, this injury is attributed to Kuldeep Kaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that all other co-accused have been granted benefit of bail.

Looking to the aforesaid circumstances, I am of the view that the petitioner has made out a case for the grant of anticipatory bail. So the petition for grant of anticipatory bail is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any

police officer;

- iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.
