Notice of motion to the official respondents.

On the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Grewal, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Let a copy of the paper book be supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the parties, the petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to ensure due protection to the life and personal liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents. They shall also ensure that the petitioner is not unduly put to harassment by repeatedly calling her to the Police Station or the office of senior police officers or visiting the house of the petitioner at odd hours, and in case she is required in any complaint a clear seven days' notice in writing be given to her to enable her to have legal recourse.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not come in the way of any recourse to law so adopted by the authorities.
