Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Rakesh Singh in case registered by way of FIR No.48 dated 09.02.2014 at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga under Sections 15/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 22.12.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been released on bail which is acceded to at the bar by learned State counsel who has categorically stated that it was only single default when the petitioner could not put in appearance before the Court.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.12.2016 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
