Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.155 dated 28.11.2016, under Section 323, 34, 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Women Police Station, District Karnal.

It is submitted that during the pendency of this petition, the matter was amicably resolved between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Written agreement dated 23.08.2017 is attached with this file. The petitioner and his wife/ complainant have decided to resume matrimonial ties. It is informed that they have started living together. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to abide by the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement arrived at on 23.08.2017. It is submitted that conditions at Clause 3(i) (ii) have since been complied with. Petitioner undertakes to

comply with the conditions mentioned at Clause 3 (iii) (iv), as well.

Learned counsel for the respondent no.2 submits that his client has no objection in case this petition is allowed subject to the petitioner strictly adhering to the terms and conditions of the settlement.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Parkash Kaur, verifies that the complainant and petitioner have resumed matrimonial ties and are living together.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, especially the settlement arrived at between the parties, but without commenting upon or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed.

In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/investigating Officer. Petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so. Petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Liberty is however afforded to respondent no.2 to move an appropriate application in this matter in case the terms and conditions of the settlement between the parties are not adhered to by the petitioner.
