TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.157 dated 20.06.2016, under Sections 21/22(B) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the parties have been heard at length.

As per prosecution version, secret information had been received as regards co-accused, Vikram Singh s/o Prem Singh being a drug peddler and he being present and proceeding towards a certain area on a motorcycle for the purpose of selling contraband. Based on such secret information, co-accused, Vikram Singh was apprehended on 20.06.2016 and an alleged recovery of 1200 narcotic tablets of alprazolam were recovered. Concededly, the alleged recovery from co-accused, Vikram Singh is of commercial quantity.

Present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the disclosure statement of main accused, Vikram Singh, who had stated that he had purchased the contraband from one Sonu who is owner of Surya Pharma Agency, Nahar, Rajasathan.

State counsel informs that the present petitioner is none other than the real brother of Sonu and was the sole license holder of Surya Pharma Agency, Nahar, Rajasathan.

In the light of such commercial quantity of contraband having been recovered, it would be a case, where a thorough and deep probe is required and which may well warrant the custodial interrogation of the present petitioner.

State counsel further informs that the challan qua main accused, Vikram Singh as also Sonu has already been presented whereas the present petitioner is evading the process of law.

This Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner, the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
