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MAHESH GROVER, J (ORAL)

We have heard the contemner on the quantum of sentence.

At the outset, the contemner has expressed his regrets for his misconduct. He has further stated that he is a former Judicial Officer and well advanced in age, presently being of 77 years. He, thus, prays for leniency.

On due consideration and looking at the facts where the contemner is a former judicial officer, well conversant with the procedures of law who has expressed regrets before us for his conduct and also noticing that he is advanced in years and of frail health, we would deem it appropriate to dispose of the contempt petition by imposing costs of Rs.5,000/- instead of inflicting any harsh punishment of imprisonment etc. to be deposited in the account of Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees Welfare Association within a period of one month from today. He, however, is warned to be careful in future and in the event of any further attempt made

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by him to belittle the Judicial Institutions or any individual, would visit
serious consequences on him.
