Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. Perused the report (Annexure P-1) shown to me, submitted by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar City to the Punjab State Human Rights Commission, Chandigarh. The following is the extract, which is relevant:-

“xxxx. On 15.04.2014 also they had injected injections at old under construction room near the Water Tank and Pawan Kumar @ Lalla after taking his intoxicant injection left for his home in the night and Raju also injected his injection and lay down and Harjit Singh consumed the over dose of the drugs on account of which he became unconscious and Raju had informed his mother in the night regarding this, but his mother told Raju that it's ok whenever he regain his conscious he will come back home, because earlier also he did not return back to home on account of drunken condition. In the morning Harjit Singh did not get conscious, then Raju again went to his house and he has taken his mother Prem Lata along in rickshaw and brought him to the Mahajan Hospital, where doctor declared him dead. Harjit Singh and his family members old enmity is going on with their neighbors who are residing opposite namely Pawan @ Lalla, and his brother Bhuchi and Kali. But

still deceased Harjit Singh used to take injection with them. On account of this both families were not keeping good relations with each other. As such, Prem Lata the mother of deceased just to implicate Lalla and his brother by giving their false name intentionally. After calling the respectable and family members of deceased it was assured that post mortem of the deceased and Visra has been sent by Doctor for obtaining report from chemical examiner kharar and after receiving the report if anything suspicious would be found then further investigation shall be conducted. xxxxxxxx.”

It is clear that the deceased-Harjit Singh, admittedly got injected the drugs repeatedly and ultimately died. The petitioner had approached Human Rights Commission, this Court and other authorities forth on the ground that the investigation should be made as to from where injections were brought for administering thereof to Harjit Singh. In my opinion, admittedly, Harjit Singh took the injections at his own risk and peril fully knowing as to what he was doing. If the petition is entertained, it would amount to harassment to the police machinery as well as all other concerned persons when the fault clearly lay with Harjit Singh himself who got the injections.

In that view of the matter, it is high time to entertain such type of petitions and trouble others.

Petition stands dismissed summarily.
