This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.161 dated 15.10.2015, under Sections 379-B/506/34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station 'C' Division, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Maninderjit Singh @ Manu.

Allegations are that on 14.10.2015 three to four unidentified persons had assaulted him and had taken away his mobile phone, an activa scooter and Rs.3200/- in cash.

The investigating agency during the course of investigation has arrested the present petitioner on 15.09.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan already stands presented.

The trial is at the very initial stage.

Under such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without making any observations on merits, prayer made in the petition is accepted. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
