SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 600 dated 24.6.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506 and 307 IPC, registered at Police Station Hisar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 27.6.2017 and trial of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the bail petition on the ground that the petitioner allegedly caused injuries to 2 persons with deadly weapon and receipt of injuries was also on the vital parts of the body, therefore, no case is made out for release of the petitioner on bail.

Having considered the facts that the petitioner allegedly caused injuries on the vital organs of the body endangering the lives of his wife and mother-in-law.

In view of the above, no case is made out for release of the petitioner on bail. The present petition stands dismissed.
