Mr. Kulwinder Kumar Banga, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner superseding the earlier counsel.

Counsel for the petitioner and complainant are *ad idem* that dispute between the parties has been settled in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the Court vide settlement agreement dated 07.04.2017. They have got no objection if the petitioner is directed to join investigation by allowing his petition for grant of bail in anticipation of arrest.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to join investigation within a period of 10 days and on his appearance, he shall be admitted to bail subject to satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. However, he shall abide by the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) he shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.
- (iv) the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement.
