Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.413 dated 03.11.2017 under Sections 186, 307, 332 and 353 IPC registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sube Singh, states that the petitioner is involved in as many as 13 cases and in 3 cases, he is at large.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner as well as the fact that he is involved in a number of other cases, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, in case it is found that the statement made by learned State counsel is contrary to record, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the present petition.
