Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 to 5 not to harass the petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is being called by the police for the reason that his son is probably an accused in certain cases. The petitioner has disowned him from his property. He further states that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 31.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.2 Director General of Police, Punjab and he would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to consider the said representation at this stage.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1, 2 and 4 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Considering the limited prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and without making any observations on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law. However, the police shall act independently and in case the petitioner is also found involved in any criminal case, the police shall be at liberty to act in accordance with law.
