Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Dr. Harinder Pal Singh and Bhalindra Singh in a criminal complaint titled as ***Amarpreet Singh Versus Dr. Harinder Pal Singh and others*** under Sections 302, 307, 325, 323, 148, 149 and 120-B read with Section 34 IPC filed by respondent No.1-complainant before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has produced a copy of order dated 28.02.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bathinda,

whereby the petitioners have been admitted on bail in pursuance of order dated 14.02.2017 passed by this Court. The same is taken on record.
