The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.217/2014 dated 04.10.2017 under Sections 392, 379-B, 427, 120-B IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ex-Sarpanch of village. A perusal of the FIR as well as impugned order shows that the allegations against the petitioner are that he is on gun point committed robbery. The petitioner was arrested on 11.10.2017.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall report to the police station concerned on Monday, Wednesday and Sunday between 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM every week in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed. Petitioner shall file undertaking before the police

station concerned that he/she will not commit/indulge in similar or any other kind of offence in future. Petitioner shall deposit his passport, if possesses, with the trial Court. Petitioner shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
