It is submitted that petitioner No.1 – Tanuja Kumar aged about 18 years has got married with petitioner No.2 – Sushil Kumar aged about 29 years against wishes of respondents No.4 and 5 who are threatening to interfere in their marital life.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 - Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation (**Annexure P-7**) submitted by the petitioners and to take necessary steps to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 or persons claiming under them. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the petitioners and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
