Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner namely Ravinder Pal alias Arvinder Pal Singh in case FIR No.0188 dated 15.09.2017 under Sections 379-B and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegation against the petitioner is of chain snatching from the daughter-in-law of the complainant while she was coming home and the petitioner is in custody since 15.9.2017.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in Court and has submitted that the petitioner was found using motorcycle with fake number.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 15.9.2017 and there is no other case pending against him, I deem it appropriate to release him on regular bail, however, subject to furnishing of heavy surety.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his heavy bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court. The petitioner shall also undertake that he shall not commit any such offence in future.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner is found indulged in any other case of similar nature, the prosecution shall be at liberty to seek cancellation of his bail.

Needless to say that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.
