This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in F.I.R. No.216 dated 25.10.2016, under Sections 365, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

On 22.12.2016, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner along with his co-accused had allegedly given beatings to Sukhdeep Singh, and Budhpreet Singh and also kidnapped Budhpreet Singh to an unknown place on 24.10.2016. Budhpreet Singh was allegedly recovered from the custody of Nathu Ram Sharma and Davinder Singh.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has not been attributed any specific role and that the co-accused of the petitioner have been granted concession of regular bail.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 9.2.2017.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that

the petitioner will join investigation on or before 7.1.2017. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Balbir Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation. The observations made by this Court while issuing notice of motion have gone un-rebutted.

In view of the above, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

The order dated 22.12.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
