2. Admittedly, the petitioner was not himself apprehended with the stolen articles. The only available material against him is the disclosure statement of the co-accused.

3. In such circumstances, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to compliance of the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
