Petitioner-Gajender Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.215 dated 10.11.2017, registered at Police Station Ambala Sadar, District Ambala, under Sections 420 and 336 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 15(2) and 15(3) of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that a raid was conducted and the present petitioner was found having allopathic medicines as well as medical instruments and he was impersonating himself as a doctor. The present petitioner was practising without any degree or licence and playing with the health of the people.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of nature and gravity of the offence, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
