Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 06 dated 26.04.2014, under Sections 21, 25 and 29 of NDPS Act and 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner's wife is suffering from kidney problem and requires transplantation. As per petitioner, there is no other adult member in his family to look after his ailing wife.

Learned State counsel affirms the fact that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from kidney problem and requires replacement of kidney. However, learned State counsel opposed the prayer on the ground that earlier also the petitioner was released on interim bail on 10.08.2017 on the same ground.

Having considered the above facts, that the petitioner's wife is suffering from kidney problem and requires transplantation and some lengthy process is to be followed by the present petitioner. As such, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a further period of four weeks so as to enable him to look after his ailing wife, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.

However, it is made clear that no such application for interim bail shall be accepted on this ground.

The present petition stands allowed.
