This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.104 dated 09.07.2016 registered under Section 306 & 34 IPC at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 21.12.2016 and vide order dated 06.02.2017 he was directed to deposit a sum of ₹1,50,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has complied with order dated 06.02.2017 by depositing the amount of ₹1,50,000/- with the court below.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custody is not required.
