Status report by way of affidavit of Kulwant Rai, PPS,
Deputy Superintendent of Police, City, Gurdaspur on behalf of
respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed in Court today which is ordered to
be taken on record.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conclude
investigation in FIR No.185 dated 17.11.2014 registered under Sections
414, 411 IPC, Section 3 of Indian Passports Act, Sections 3, 4 of Official
Secret Act and Sections 18, 21 and 22 of NDPS Act, at Police Station
City Gurdaspur .

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that as a
