SHEKHER DHAWAN, J.

Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 105 dated 28.10.2017, under Section 379B IPC, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was falsely implicated in this case for snatching a mobile phone, whereas, he is an innocent person and not involved in any other case and trial of the case still to take some more time, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel affirmed the fact that there is no other case of similar nature against the present petitioner but opposed the bail petition on the ground that he was apprehended on the spot, so he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the above facts and the facts that the petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2017; trial of the case still to take some more time and their being no other case of similar nature against the

petitioner, the present petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands disposed of.
