Petitioners seek grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.53 dated 15.06.2016, registered under Sections 302, 148, 149, 34 IPC at Police Station Rureke Kalan, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relied upon order dated 16.02.2016 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.43006 of 2016 in the case of co-accused Chamkaur Singh.

FIR was registered on the allegation that Jeewan Singh gave a blow with wooden log on the back of the brother of the complainant. The brother of the complainant raised alarm and

started running outside the house. The complainant-party started following him. The brother of the complainant was found in unconscious condition on the next day, i.e. 14.06.2016 near the bridge of drain in the ditches. He ultimately died in the Hospital. Petitioners were not named in the FIR, nor any injury was attributed to them.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of granting bail to co-accused Chamkaur Singh.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, it will be just and expedient to grant benefit of regular bail to the petitioners.

Let the petitioners be enlarged on bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
