Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.474 dated 28.10.2016 under Sections 170, 384, 420 of IPC registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat.

The complainant alleged that when he was present on his sweet shop, then a car came in front of the shop. The driver of the car came out and stated that Food Supply Inspector from C.M. Flying, Chandigarh has come. The complainant was asked to pay a sum of Rs.10,000/-, otherwise he would take sample of the sweets. The complainant and his neighbours who were sitting with the complainant became suspicious and they asked the driver to show his identity. The driver as well as occupant of the car became frightened and,

thereafter, they tried to ran away. They were apprehended. The name of the driver came to be known as Deepak whereas occupant of the car came to be known as Krishan.

Allegations are of attempted extortion and impersonation. The act did not culminate in any action. The petitioner is in custody since 28.10.2016. The case is triable by Magistrate. No amount has been recovered from the petitioner. Challan has already been presented to the Court.

In view of aforesaid, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
