According to the reply in shape of affidavit of Siddharath Dhanda, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, District Hisar, filed by learned State counsel on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3, the petitioners have given their affidavits to the effect that they have no danger to their life and liberty any more in future. However, the petitioner No.1, present in person, submits that still she apprehends danger from her parents.

Considering the seriousness of the matter, Head Constable Sunil Kumar, present in Court, is directed to take both the petitioners to the Protection Home and keep them there in safe custody till there exists danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.
