Despite the order dated 10.1.2017 directing the petitioner to place on record the medico legal report at the time of admission of the deceased to the hospital, and more than 3 opportunities having been granted for that purpose, the same has still not been filed.

In view of the above, I see no reason to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.

However, dismissal of the petition shall not be construed to be any comment on the merits of the matter, even for the purpose of any application for regular bail filed at any subsequent stage, if the case comes to such a stage.
