Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.877 dated 27.09.2016, under Sections 21C/27A/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind (Haryana).

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 1000 grams of contraband was effected from the petitioner as also her husband co-accused, namely, Vinod.

As per report of the Forensic Science Laboratory, the recovery is of heroin.

In the light of heavy and commercial recovery effected, this Court would not be inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the benefit of regular bail in view of the bar envisaged under Section 37 of the NDPS Act.

Petition is dismissed.
