The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.389 dated 26.10.2016 registered under Sections 409, 411, 420, 120-B IPC; Section 137 of Indian Electricity Act and Section 13 of Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamunanagar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner who is working as Junior Engineer was alleged to have sold some transformer entrusted him for repairs.

This Court had made interim order on 22.12.2016. The petitioner has jointed investigation. The petition was kept pending as some transformers were not received back by the Uttar Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam (in short, UHBVN). Now learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record letter dated 18.07.2017, which is marked

as Mark X for identification. This letter shows that all the transformers have been returned.

In that view of the matter, the interim order dated 22.12.2017 is made absolute.

Liberty is reserved in favour of the UHBVN to take departmental action against the petitioner.

Disposed of accordingly.
