INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Hardev Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.248 dated 17.10.2017, registered at Police Station Chheharata, Amritsar City, District Amritsar, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner took ₹2 lakhs each for two persons from the complainant side to get them recruited in the army by telling that his brother-in-law is a Colonel in the army.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I

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do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
