Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.177 dated 16.10.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Tigaon, District Faridabad.

According to the prosecution, in the day time on 15.10.2017, the petitioners alongwith their co-accused Pawan, Agit and Shekhar attacked the complainant party and caused injury to it with Dandas and Lathis. Thereafter, in the evening around 9:00 p.m., co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sikandar @ Lal and Bhagwat again fired shots upon the complainant party, when they were standing in front of their house.

Learned counsel inter-alia contends that no specific role has been attributed to the petitioners. Even otherwise, settlement has taken place between the parties vide compromise Annexure-P1 and the petitioners are in

Considering over all facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are granted regular bail, during the trial, subject to their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
