KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent No.3 has filed a false application against the petitioner. The said application is found to be false by the police. The petitioner has moved representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-3) to respondent No.2 for initiating the proceedings under Section 182 IPC against respondent No.3. The said representation has not been decided so far.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-3) and dispose of the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
