The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 0055 dated 14.07.2017, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Banga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 10 injections each containing 2 ml of Buprenorphine were recovered from the petitioner, which would be less than the threshold of 20 grams as the commercial quantity. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody for over four and half months since his arrest on 14.07.2017 and is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner has been in custody for over four and half months and quantity of Buprenorphine

recovered from him is less than the threshold of commercial quantity and he is not involved in any other case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Jaskaran Singh @ Jassi is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
