TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.38 dated 28.03.2007, under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kartarpur, Tehsil and District Jalandhar.

Briefly, it may be noticed that the FIR had been registered on the allegations put forth by the complainant that he has been duped of a certain sum of money by the present petitioner as also co-accused on the pretext of sending his relatives abroad.

On a previous date of hearing i.e. 13.02.2017, counsel appearing for the petitioner had stated that a compromise had been effected with the complainant. That apart, Mr. G.S.Guri, Advocate appearing for the complainant concedes to the factum of the compromise with the present petitioner.

On 13.02.2017, this Court had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days and upon his doing so, he was held entitled to interim bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner has produced for perusal of this Court a certified copy of an order dated 21.02.2017 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar and which would show that the petitioner has duly appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail upon having furnished requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

In view of the above and coupled with the fact that the petitioner has already joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Order dated 13.02.2017, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
