The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a direction to the official respondent No. 2 to enquire and take action against respondents No. 3. In this regard she has also approached the authorities by way of complaint dated 17.12.2017 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the complaint dated 17.12.2017 (Annexure P-8), in a time bound manner.
