Mr. Sunil Mallan, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case bearing FIR No.456 dated 14.11.2016, under Sections 336, 427, 506, IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Division A Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has been involved in this case falsely at the instance of complainant due to some enmity between the two. It is further his

contention that as per the case of prosecution two shots were fired by the petitioner with his licensed double barrel gun, but no injury was caused to any person. Further he has prayed that petitioner is ready to join investigation and as such he be granted the benefit of pre-arrest bail.

As per the FIR, petitioner is the main accused in this case. On 14.11.2016 in the evening, he abused the complainant and fired a shot at him with rifle with an intention to kill him which anyhow hit on the glass of three-wheeler. The second shot fired by him hit at the godown.

In the light of the above allegations against the petitioner, no case for the grant of pre-arrest bail is made out. His custodial interrogation is required, so the petition stands dismissed and disposed of accordingly.

Nothing said hereinabove will have any effect on the merits of the case.
